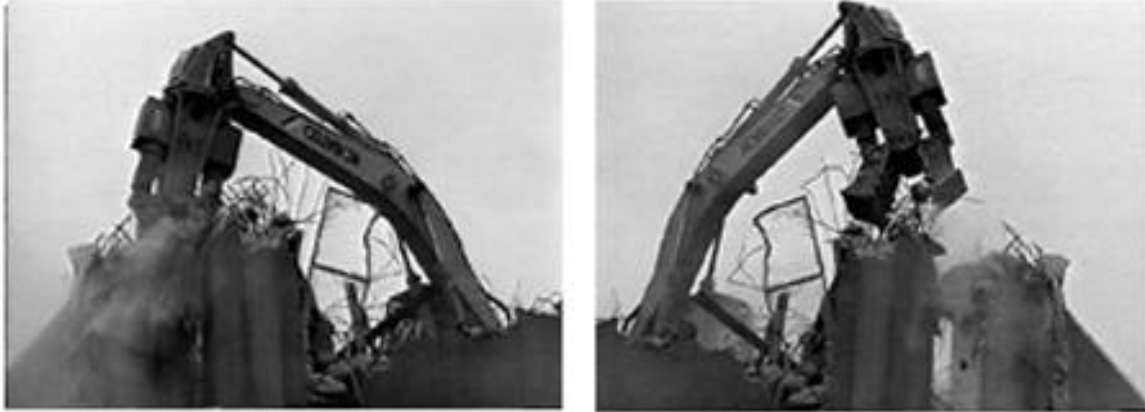


EQUILIBRIUM

A huge machine gently destroys a building while simultaneously, another machine reconstructs it in reversed time. The building is devoured as it is vomited into existence. On two screens, staggered video loops trace a jagged helix through time. 2000.

Van McElwee has been producing and exhibiting experimental video since 1976 and has been the recipient of numerous grants and awards, including the American Film Institute Independent Filmmaking Award, The National Endowment for the Arts Independent Production Fund (seven time recipient), and a travel grant from the Government of India. McElwee's work has been exhibited extensively worldwide and is represented by The Kitchen in New York, Trabant Gallery in Vienna, Argos Gallery in Brussels, London Electronic Arts in the UK and Heure Exquise! in France. McElwee is Professor of Media and Video Area Head at Webster University's School of Communications, St. Louis.
